

Getting Started at ChristianCourses.com


There are three categories of courses at ChristianCourses.com: free courses, paid certificate courses, and our newest graduate level courses.

First, if you haven't already registered, please do so. In the top right-hand corner of the home page, look for the **Login** block. Click on **Create new account**.

Submit all required information on the registration form. How your name appears in your registration is how your name will appear on any certificates you earn. ChristianCourses.com does not sell or rent your personal information. See our privacy information at ChristianCourses.com for more details.

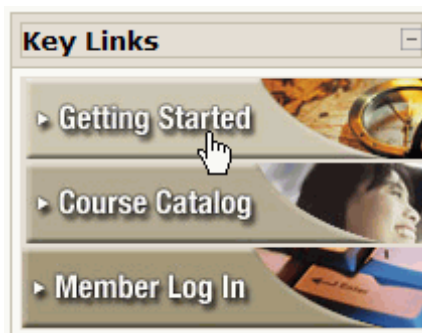
Note: Our certificate courses can be taken for Continuing Education credit (Certificate of Completion). Continuing Education credits are not available for FastTrax courses or the non-credit courses.

FastTrax courses are courses that have fewer exercises and assignments than the regular courses. In some cases, they are courses that have not yet been approved for Continuing Education credit. There are not both FastTrax and regular versions of the same course. They are one or the other.



After completing the registration, please read the **Getting Started** document. There's a button for the Getting Started page at the top of the left column of the home page. This gives you all the basic information about using ChristianCourses.com in a fairly short document. It's located at:

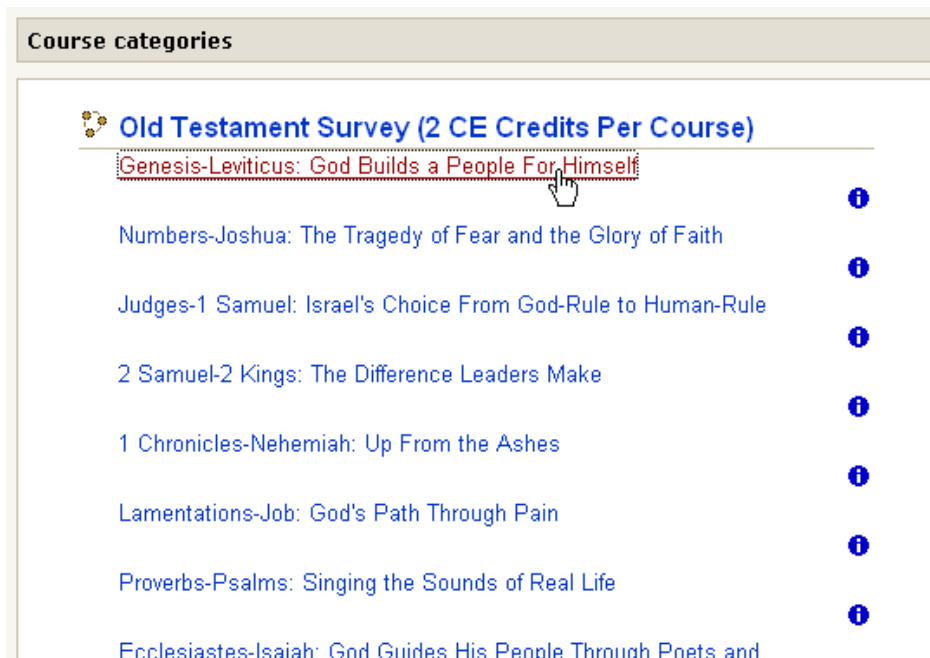


Navigating ChristianCourses.com

Log in at
rbc.christiancourses.com

This puts you on the
ChristianCourses.com
home page (right).

Choose the course you
want to study from the
Course categories list as
shown to the right. The
Course categories list is
outlined in the screen-
capture (right) in a red
box. Note whether the
course category is a
credit category or a non-
credit category when you
look for the course you
want to take.



Click on the course you want to
study (see image to the left).

Read the information about the course at the top of the page.

Be sure to read the syllabus and check to see if you have all the necessary plug-ins installed for the course.







When you're ready to start the course, click on the course page where you want to begin (typically Lesson One, page 1.1 or 1.0). See screencapture on the right.

This will put you on the first page of the lesson you want to study.

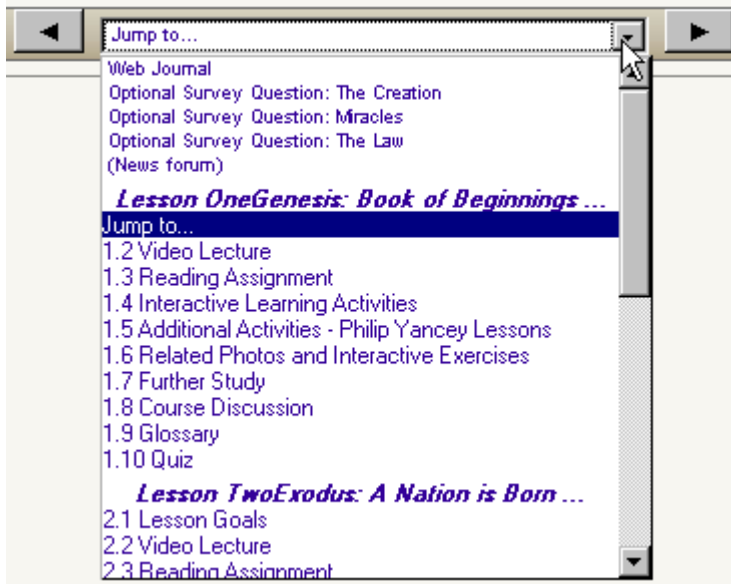


In this lesson you will study the story of creation, the introduction of [sin](#) into God's creation, and the plan God designed to build a community of people to love and serve Him.
